Example:	<i>I read this book last night with my mum. This is my favourite page. I chose this page because I like horses.</i>
9-10	Do you have any pets? Tell us about them. If you don't, what pet would you like and why?
Example:	<i>I have 2 dogs. Their names are Buddy and Bonnie. Buddy is a big black Labrador and Bonnie is a small white and brown Jack Russell.</i>
